




that the following election will be four years hence—with our

Important Voter's Information from Elections Canada, who asked us to get the word out that you need to have **PHOTO**

ID with your address at the polling station. Just bringing your voter registration card will not be sufficient. Also remember your passport is NOT allowed, as it does not include your address.

Option 1—show one original piece of photo ID with your name and address (ie; driver's license). It must be issued by a government agency.

Option 2—Show two original pieces of ID. One must have your address (ie; health care card and hydro bill). Option 3— Swear an oath and have an elector who knows you vouch for you.
