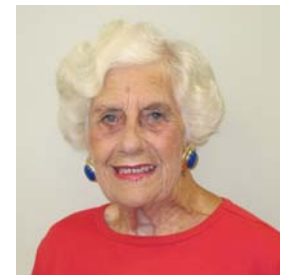
**Jeff Bridge** is our always busy Election Readiness Chair.

Important Voter's Information from Elections Canada, who asked us to get the word out that you need to have **PHOTO**

**ID with your address** at the polling station. Just bringing your voter registration card will not be sufficient. Also remember your passport is NOT allowed, as it does not include your address.

**Option 1**—show one original piece of photo ID with your name and address (ie; driver's license). It must be issued by a government agency.

**Option 2**—Show two original pieces of ID. One must have your address (ie; health care card and hydro bill).

**Option 3**— Swear an oath and have an elector who knows you vouch for you.
